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Island Inn adding more rooms in Friday Harbor

Misty Todd built a luxury condo complex in Friday Harbor on San Juan Island and then converted the project to a hotel when the condo market tanked. Now she is expanding the hotel.

Todd hired Wellman and Zuck to add four guest rooms to the Island Inn at 123 West St.

Fish Mackay Architects designed the rooms, which will go into a lower level space that was

originally intended to be commercial condos.

The hotel is open during construction. When work is done May 15, the inn will have 16 rooms.

The inn is near the ferry dock, on property that was once used for fuel and oil storage.

Todd said she is an artist and interior designer, and hadn't developed anything before she opened the condo complex in 2009. Units were priced between \$500,000 and \$1.5 million, but didn't sell.

The hotel is about 40 percent occupied, but business generally picks up in the summer.

GGLO designed the condo project, and Wellman and Zuck built it.
